Dear Holton Families:

Last night, at the Holton Board of Education meeting the Board approved continuing the requirement for indoor facial coverings for all students, staff, and visitors and approved a student mask waiver to be signed by a parent/guardian to exempt student mask use through the 2021-2022 school year. A new waiver must be completed for your child to be exempt for the mask requirement but will be applicable for the remainder of the school year. This waiver is available in all district offices and is enclosed.

Regardless of the waiver, masks are still required on district transportation due to a federal order. The Holton Board of Education will review public health data and recommendations again at the October 4, 2021 board meeting to determine if any changes need to be made to our Safety Protocols. Masks continue to be available in all of our building offices.

These are not easy times or decisions. Holton Public Schools will continue to support the health and safety of our students, staff, and community and work to minimize disruptions to your child's learning.

I will continue to update you on any changes. Thank you for your messages of support and encouragement during these unprecedented times.

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Safety Protocols - Universal Masks Required

Face Coverings - Indoors	As recommended by Public Health - Muskegon County, CDC, and multiple medical associations, face coverings are required indoors for all students, staff, and visitors regardless of vaccination. This may change as we will adhere to any changes in public health orders. Student mask waivers are available for parents/guardians to sign providing an option to not adhere to this requirement.		
Face Coverings - Transportation	As required by the CDC and legal recommendation, all students and staff are required to wear a face covering on district provided transportation.		
Daily Screening	Students and staff should not report to school if they feel sick or have been ordered to isolate and/or quarantine by Public Health or a physician.		
Athletics	There currently are no required safety protocols for athletics. We will follow MHSAA and MDHHS guidance.		
Quarantine, Testing, and Recovery	Holton Public Schools are required to follow the requirements from Public Health - Muskegon County in the event of a symptomatic student or staff member or a positive test result. Public Health - Muskegon County will direct the process for quarantine and contact tracing. Rapid testing is available for students and staff if requested and test kit availability.		
Symptom Monitoring	Students and staff feeling ill should not attend school or any school events. Symptomatic students sent home from school should be kept home in accordance with protocols established by the local health department. Students and staff who have been exposed to or tested positive for COVID-19 should remain home as directed by the local health department.		
Hand Washing	All students and staff should wash hands frequently. If soap and water are not available, students and staff should use alcohol-based hand sanitizer, which will be provided.		
Social Distancing	To help support social distancing, class sizes will be reduced with added staff. Students and staff are encouraged to maintain social distance of at least 3 feet and wear a face covering indoors.		
Visitors	Parents and visitors are allowed in the building in accordance with board policy and procedures. All parents and visitors must adhere to district safety protocols. Facial coverings are required for all visitors.		
Air Quality	The district is working to install ionization units in all classrooms to reduce pathogens, allergies, and improve overall indoor air quality.		
Food Service	For students in attendance at school, school meals will be served in buildings. Social distancing will be encouraged. Once per week, meal kits will be provided to virtual students who elect to receive these meals.
