Students also have the option of participating in the Early College of Muskegon County program, which allows a student to earn both their associate degree and their high school diploma concurrently.



Over \$630,000 in scholarships were awarded to the graduating class of 2020. Resident students who graduate from Holton Public Schools and meet the eligibility criteria, will receive the Muskegon Area Promise two-year college scholarship.
